RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Advanced entries are encouraged. Contestants entered by July 3rd will be in pre-draw.
2. Entry fees in the correct amount must accompany the entry form. There will be no refunds on accepted entries. Make Cashier Check or Money order payable to: Orick Chamber of Commerce (OCC). Credit cards may be used on day of to enter.
3. All judges' decisions will be final. Judges can disqualify any contestant for unsportsman-like conduct and will be disqualified from all events.
4. No entry forms will be accepted unless signed by contestant. Waiver must be signed by parent or guardian, if applicable.
5. Everyone must pay to watch the events. No parents will be allowed in the arena area unless prior approval is obtained.
6. BARRELS, POLES, SINGLE STAKE, & BIRANGLE—one run per horse per event.
7. All-Around prizes will be given in the following categories. 13 & under, 14-18, 19 & over. A tie will be decided by a coin toss. Paybacks as follows: 1-4 entries = one money: 5-8 entries = two monies: 9-12 entries = three monies: 13-20 entries = four monies: 21 or more entries= five monies. Prizes only in Lead Line. All around category must have three participants or category will be canceled.
8. Button up shirts with collar, short or long sleeves and boots required.
9. **Maximum of 10 horses are to be waiting in the holding pen at once. These must ONLY be the next 10 horses drawn after each rider.**
10. Age classification—You must be the age as of January 1, 2019.
11. **Checks will be given out one hour after Jackpot is over. You can pick them up under the tent at the front ticket gate. Do NOT go to announcer's booth.**

Check in time will be 7:30-8:00am at tent next to main ticket gate. No horses allowed in main parking area, by front gate or concessions.
